FAST refers to the amount of food eaten. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. This means that only one full meal and two smaller meals are to be eaten on these two days. Solid foods between meals are to be avoided.
ABSTINENCE means that all Catholics over 14 years of age are obligated to abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent**.
