This means that only one full meal and two smaller meals are to be eaten on these two days. Solid foods between meals are to be avoided. **ABSTINENCE** - All Catholics over **14** years of age are obligated to abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday** and **all Fridays of Lent**.
