January 12th – “Caring for our Aging Parents”

Jim Kebe from Saint Catharine parish will present this session to address pastoral and practical issues affecting individuals and families with aging parents. Those in attendance will also be directed to community resources that assist the senior population.

January 19th – “End of Life Issues”

The Diocesan office of Social Concerns will lead a discussion about end of life issues – Catholic perspectives on choices for medical care, types of medical care directives, and options for Hospice in our community.

January 26th – “Social Security and Medicare – options in Ohio”

The Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program (OSHIIP) will present information on Medicare options available in central Ohio, with resources available to help with Medicare choice decisions. We will also discuss Social Security Retirement planning. You may want to bring your most recent pre-retirement Social Security Statement (generally issued annually about 3 months before your birthday).

February 2nd – “Long Term Care Options Panel Discussion” – Sponsored by Father Hohman KofC Council 5253

Paul Yarger, a Financial Planner and member of St Pius X, will lead a panel discussion on Long Term Care options. Panel members will include an attorney, insurance advisor, and representatives from the Ohio Dept of Aging, Dept of Veterans Services, local LTC facilities and in-home care programs. Learn about choices in providing LTC assistance for you and your family members and resources that are available in the local area.
